Historical note: Kieran’s third place led to HW’s first individual medal in this event since Adrian Marriott also finished third in 2001 on Wimbledon Common while previous to that Simon Rayner was also third at Coulsdon in 1993.

HW took the team title at Epsom in 1974 when the individual winner was HW member John Roberts, but then competing for South London H.

In 1978 at Bristol HW was second team home while way back in 1960 the former Hercules AC tasted victory at West Wickham when led home by second placed Ernie Earl.

A note from Bob Holt

Pleased to read about Kieran White's bronze medal in South of Thames Senior. My congratulations to him. Your reference to the old HAC's team victory in the event back in 1960 reminded me that five years after that (Hercules AC) HAC were again successful in the 1965 race held in snowy and icy conditions at Bracknell and won by Pete Yeates (WS&E). For those interested in ancient history the scorers in that winning team were:-12 -Bob Holt; 15 -Mike Beevor; 21 -John Halliday; 23 -Dave Holt (hampered by an injured foot); 37 -Mick Beard (eldest brother of David Beard); 43 -Alan Turner.

HAC team also won the trophy for the lowest score of their 12 man team. We had depth in those days! Victory at Bracknell had been preceded earlier in the season when HAC won the team event in the South of Thames ‘Junior’ over a muddy course at Aldershot. Scorers in that race (surprisingly won as you will see by Dave!) were:-
